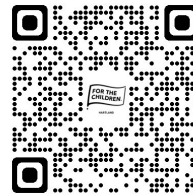

Our Mission

To mobilize the local Church to create life-changing moments for children who have experienced relational trauma.

What is Royal Family KIDS Camp?

Royal Family KIDS Camp is a five-day, four-night camp for children ages 7-11, who have suffered relational trauma, neglect, abuse, abandonment or are in out-of-home care.

Royal Family KIDS Camp Hartland is sponsored by Oakwood Church in Hartland, and is staffed by volunteers who are screened and trained to work with kids at risk. The cost of Camp is covered by businesses and individuals who care about children.

At camp, every child is paired with another camper, and carefully matched with an adult counselor. A strict rule of 2 adults always in eyesight, ensures each child is in safe hands.

The encouraging attention of caring adults, positive family role modeling, building friendships with other children like them, and the beauty of playing in the great outdoors, all result in a host of wholesome, positive memories and enhanced self-esteem.



A Week of Positive Memories

Each child is greeted by warm cheers as they step off of the camp bus.

Every day is filled with a fun variety of activities such as: hiking, swimming, woodworking, horses, crafts, singing, storytelling, boating, and a special event!

A freshly made bed, soft cuddly friend, and a bedtime story await the first night. Camp Grandma & Grandpa share “safe hugs”, tell stories, and deliver camp mail.

Lots of friends are made. Hope and trust are reborn. Fun and laughter fill the camp. Children receive their very own photo album to help preserve precious camp memories.
